He has prepared choruses for performances at Carnegie Hall, and has frequently served as an adjudicator for events sponsored by the American Choral Directors' Association, the American Guild of Organists and the New Jersey Folk Festival. He studied with Thomas Spacht and Eugene Roan, and holds degrees with honors in organ performance and church music from Towson University in Baltimore and Westminster Choir College of Rider University in Princeton.
